I do some Javascript programming from time to time. Just though I should start keeping some useful notes for my future reference (sometimes I waste time looking up something I have actually gone through :p).

Variable Declaration

I always declare use `strict` and use `var` to declare a variable. However I just found out alternatives: `let` and `const`, which is more relatable to my background in C programming. Both those options comes with `block scope` - before ES6(2015), Javascript only supports `global scope` and `function scope`. So, I will start to use `let` instead of `var` from now on.

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
